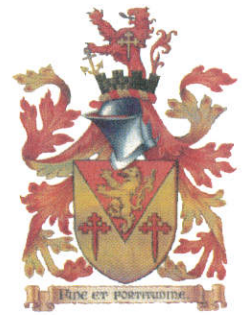

ARRANGEMENTS FOR 11+ FAMILIARISATION LESSONS

2nd and 9th February 2019 and 2nd and 9th March 2019

This letter details the arrangements we have put in place for these sessions.

Car Parking

The school gates will be open at 8.20am. You may park on site, but spaces are limited. Please enter the private road off Middlesex Avenue and park in any of the bays along the road.

Reception

Parents are asked to arrive at the school between **8.30am and 8.45am**. **We will be registering in the Dining Hall**, which will be signposted on the day. Once your child has been registered you are free to leave.

Requirements

We ask that your child wears their **school uniform**. Please ensure they have a pen, pencil, eraser and ruler a pencil sharpener and a reading book. In addition we suggest that your child either brings a snack or they can purchase something to have during the break.

What to do while your daughter/son is in class

We will be running a coffee bar in the Dining Hall for parents who wish to remain on site which will be raising money for our students' upcoming World Challenge expedition. Alternatively there is a park/recreation ground near the school (Blenheim Park), or it may be possible to go into Southend or Leigh to shop. However, with Saturday traffic, you may find the time available is very limited.

Programme

The programme for the two mornings will be the same, one Saturday will be English and the other Saturday will be Mathematics:

Saturday

8.30am	Pupils arrive and register; parents depart
9.00am	Session 1
10 – 10:20am	Break
10.20am	Session 2
11.20am	End

Although we are providing these classes to help your daughter/son understand the nature and style of the questions, I am afraid it will not be possible for the teachers to advise you of the likelihood of their success.

Collection of your daughter/son

Children must be collected - they will not be allowed to walk home on their own. Parents should return at 11am to the Dining Hall where their child was registered in the morning ready for when they finish at about 11:20am. Children must be collected by 11.45am, after this time there will not be staff to supervise them.
