11+ Familiarisation Classes 2019

Westcliff High School for Girls is organising classes for Year 5 girls and boys who would benefit from the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the types of questions they will meet in the 11+ selection tests. **This activity will particularly benefit pupils who have not received help at primary school and/or are not being tutored for the tests.**

Pupils need to be able to attend two consecutive Saturday morning sessions; one week will be Maths and the other English. The Mathematics paper includes a section on non-verbal applied reasoning. The English papers include sections on verbal/literacy applied reasoning and extended writing.

Saturday 2nd and Saturday 9th February

or

Saturday 2nd and Saturday 9th March

The program for the two mornings will be:

8.30am	Pupils arrive and register; parents depart
9.00am	Session 1
10 – 10:20am	Break
10.20am	Session 2
11.20am	End

Parents will be expected to arrive back at the school for 11:10am in good time to collect their child when they finish at 11:20am.

It will not be possible for the school to supervise pupils beyond 11:45am as no staff will be available.
