BMAT, OXBRIDGE TESTS, LNAT and UKCAT

The **BMAT** test (Biomedical Admissions Test), is due to take place on Wednesday 31 October 2018.

Please let me know if you wish to take this test by **Thursday 27 September**. The closing date for entries is 15 October and any entries made after this date will be subject to a late fee.

The fee for the BMAT is £46 and you will need to pay for this on Parent Pay. Please provide a copy of the email confirmation together with the following details:

- Full Name
- Date of Birth
- UCAS Number
- Name of College/University/s
- Name of Course/s
- Course Code/s
- Any special requirements

The tests listed below are required for entry to Oxford University and will also take place on the **31 October**, for which there is no charge. The final registration deadline is the 15 October.

- **ELAT** (English Literature Admissions Test)
- **CAT** (Classics Admissions Test)
- **HAT** (History Aptitude Test)
- **MAT** (Mathematics Admissions Test)
- **MLAT** (Modern Languages Admissions Test)
- **OLAT** (Oriental Languages Aptitude Test)
- **PAT** (Physics Aptitude Test) – Physics and/or Engineering
- **TSA** (Thinking Skills Assessment) - for some courses at Oxford, Cambridge and UCL
- You can also sit the **Oxford University Philosophy Test**

In addition Cambridge University also now require tests in the following subjects. These too will be sat on **31 October** and you must register by 15 October.

- **ASNCAA** (Anglo-Saxon, Norse and Celtic Admissions Assessment)
- **AMESAA** (Asian and Middle Eastern Studies Admissions Assessment)
- **ECAA** (Economics Admissions Assessment)
- **ENGAA** (Engineering Admissions Assessment)
- **ELAT** (English Literature Admissions Test)
- **GAA** (Geography Admissions Assessment)
- **HAA** (History Admissions Assessment)
- **HSPSAA** (Human, Social and Political Sciences Admissions Assessment)
- **NSAA** (Natural Sciences Admissions Assessment)
- **PBSAA** (Psychological and Behavioural Sciences Admissions Assessment)
- **TAA** (Theology Admissions Assessment)

If your chosen course demands that you sit any of the above, you need to provide me with the same information as that required for the BMAT.

LNAT (Law National Aptitude Test) – register and book the test online at www.lnat.ac.uk (for Oxford entry register by **05 October** to sit the test on or before **20 October** at a local centre).

UKCAT (UK Clinical Aptitude Test) – you can register and book the test online at www.ukcat.ac.uk. You need to register before the **18 September** - booking closes at midday on 01 October. The fee is £87 and the test can be taken at any time before the **02 October** at a local test centre.

TMUA (Test for Mathematics for University Admission) -_If you are applying to study Mathematics courses at Durham University, Lancaster University, the University of Warwick, the University of Sheffield or the University of Southampton, you are encouraged to take this test as part of your application. The fee is £30. The final registration deadline is **15 October** and the test will take place on the **31 October**.
