Entry to the sixth form requires at least 11 points gained in eight GCSE subjects (**9 = 3, 8 = 3, 7 = 2, 6 = 1**). Students **must** have **English Language** and **Mathematics** at a minimum grade of 4. **Provisional places will be offered to applicants subject to this condition.** Points may also be gained from some vocational qualifications, including OCR Nationals and BTEC 2 Qualifications. Points will be awarded as follows:-

Distinction Star = 3 Points Distinction = 2 Points Merit = 1 Point.

(A **maximum** of 2 vocational qualifications can be used).

Offers will be made in mid February 2019 and students will be asked to confirm these places within two weeks.
