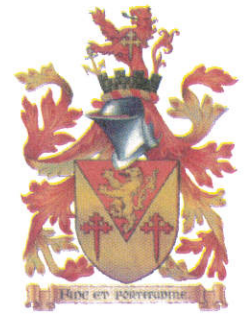

Dear Student

I am writing to provide you with further details of our two day Induction Event which is very nearly here. All students who have paid and sent appropriate consent and medical forms are invited to Day 1 - on Monday 1st July.

Please note that if you are arriving later in the day you should report to the main school office who will direct you to our registration tent which is situated on the school field near the Sports Hall. You will get all relevant instructions and your team T-Shirt from there.

On Tuesday 2nd July we will be offering you the chance to meet teachers in the subjects that you have chosen. A timetable of lessons will be given to you at the start of the day which will include a session about the Sixth Form led by myself. On this day you will also register with the Year 12 students who will be part of your Form next year.

The school has a dress code which we will tell you more about on the day but on 2nd July you are asked to choose clothes which are smart casual (no denim or shorts) which are suitable for work.
